Synopsis:

Paula, Monika and Dympie just wanna have a good night at the pub. So do Stephan and Gordon. But the band isn't playing, the waiters are ignoring them, and no-one can keep their issues to themselves.

After Dinner follows a hilariously disappointing night out. On the surface, a comedy of characters, but underneath the farce lies social issues that affect us all.

Wyndham Theatre Company is auditioning for 5 brilliant actors for our upcoming production. Age and gender descriptions are a guide, but we will happily cast the right person for the job.

Characters:

Dympie - female identifying, mid-late 30s, a negative nelly, set in her ways, determined to have fun.

Paula - female identifying, late 20s- early 30s, a dreamer and an outlier who struggles to assert herself.

Monica - female identifying, mid-late 30s, recently widowed, teetering on the edge of grief and freedom.

Stephen - male identifying, mid 30s, just wants to chase tail and sink some beers.

Gordon - male identifying, mid 30s, just wants to connect with his fellow man, a non-drinker.

Please prepare a 2 minute monologue of your choosing. We will also run through some cold reads of parts of the script on the day. No preparation of the script is necessary.
